WHAT: For the next six Saturdays, Dec. 22 – Jan. 26, from 12 to 2 pm, UCare will offer free hot cocoa, hand and head warmers, and bicycle selfies at the new SKATE THE STAR ice rink located at the North entrance of Mall of America[®] (MOA). On four specific Saturdays – Dec. 29, Jan. 5, Jan. 12 and Jan. 19 – UCare will also cover the cost of skate rentals. The ice rink is free to guests and UCare will cover the \$5 skate rentals – with 100 percent of proceeds going to the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Twin Cities.

Free skate rentals will make the iconic Minnesota ice skating experience accessible for Mall guests, in alignment with UCare's goal of making health care accessible to all Minnesotans.

UCare's skate rental donations to Boys & Girls Clubs helps the Clubs advance its mission of enabling all young people, especially those who need it most, to become productive, caring, responsible citizens. Proceeds will help build its education fund.

In addition to free skate rentals, on all Saturdays, UCare will serve hot cocoa and provide free hand warmers and head band warmers to keep skaters comfortable. Skaters are invited to pose for UCare bicycle selfies, as well.
