The American Cancer Society (ACS) and The National HPV Vaccination Roundtable (HPVRT) are partnering with rural healthcare organizations through a learning community to improve HPV vaccination among 9–12-year-olds.

Through a series of 10- virtual sessions and peer-based learning, the rural disparities HPV vaccination learning community will use quality improvement (QI) and evidence-based interventions to increase vaccine rates. This no-cost, practical how-to learning community is a forum for health partners to gain knowledge, exchange promising practices, and talk through challenges to increasing HPV vaccinations in rural settings.
