Elderly Waiver updates to resources and trainings

UCare has updated provider resources for the Elderly Waiver (EW) program. HPV vaccine at age nine

New guidance from the American Cancer Society seeks to improve on-time HPV vaccination coverage for both series initiation and completion by recommending providers start the series at age nine. UCare Medical Director Dr. Bruce Cantor, a pediatrician with over 20 years of clinical practice, says, "HPV is responsible for over 33,000 vaccine-preventable cancers each year in the US, such as oropharyngeal cancer. Initiating the HPV vaccine at age nine will keep our children healthy and save lives!"

Together, the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the American Cancer Society provide an alternate Immunization Quality Improvement for Providers (IQIP) program to support and assist clinics. UCare data reports available

UCare provides local data to county public health and human service directors on a quarterly basis. The reports focus on topics of interest to county public health and human service departments such as utilization of emergency departments, hospitalization rates and telehealth usage, demographics of our membership, and performance on select Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) measures. UCare shares data for both UCare and the county. The UCare numbers include all counties where we have contracts to offer Minnesota Health Care Programs. The data we provide shows population trends on a quarterly basis and includes up to eight previous quarters for trending purposes.

UCare also produces monthly prenatal and postpartum reports to county public health agencies to aid in identification of members who may benefit from county maternal and public health services. Agencies can use this report for outreach to pregnant or postpartum members. The reports are posted on our UCare secure file transfer site. Additionally, UCare can provide reports by request for counties looking to perform outreach efforts to members overdue for dental care, well child visits and blood lead tests. Please contact ucarecountyrelations@ucare.org if you would like to receive these reports.

Partnership Opportunity: UCare Flu Clinics in collaboration with Thrifty White and Cub Pharmacies

UCare is partnering with local public health agencies and clinics to provide flu clinics, with a focus on rural counties. If your agency is interested, Cub or Thrifty White Pharmacies will travel to your site to provide vaccines. Past sites include community and county events, health fairs, food drives, adult day centers, and religious sites. Based on location, Cub can also provide a mobile health unit, expanding your options for location and access! The pharmacy will provide the supplies and staff. Partners must have one person on-site the day of the event to provide support and access to the site. UCare has Spanish, Somali and Hmong Health Improvement Specialists to help complete consent forms (based on availability). Available vaccines will include the flu shot, FluMist® nasal vaccine and COVID-19 vaccines.

Activity Tracker plus Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) device

For UCare's Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO) and UCare Connect + Medicare members.

Eligible members can get an easy-to-use activity tracker plus Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) device.* Features of the PERS device include:

- 24/7 emergency call-for-help to a support agent directly through the watch
- Step and heart rate tracking to help members reach their health goals
- Built-in GPS to support members inside and outside their home
- Ready-to-use right out of the box, so members do not need to set it up or pair it to a cell phone or Wi-Fi

To order, members must contact their care coordinator. If they do not know who their care coordinator is, they can contact UCare Customer Service at the number on the back of their member ID card.

*Members with a hypertension diagnosis who use the device are also eligible for a blood pressure monitor.

Dental access for members

UCare Dental Connection helps members manage their dental care in one phone call. Representatives help members:

- Find a dental provider or dental home
- Schedule dental appointments, including appointments for follow up and specialty care
- Coordinate transportation to dental appointments
- Answer dental benefit and claims questions
- Coordinate interpreter services for dental appointments

Dental Kits

For UCare's MSHO and UCare Connect + Medicare members.

Members are eligible to receive the Adult Dental Kit once every three years. For the years the member does not receive the Adult Dental Kit, they can request the Adult Dental Refill Kit.

Adult Dental Kit:

- Rechargeable toothbrush with charger
- Two extra brush heads
- Toothpaste
- Dental floss



Adult Dental Refill Kit:

- Two toothbrush heads
- Toothpaste
- Dental floss



To order the kit, eligible members call the UCare Customer Service number on the back of their member identification card.

Dental Care on the move

The UCare Mobile Dental Clinic (MDC) provides dental check-ups, cleanings and simple restorative care to UCare members who have limited access to quality dental care. All care is provided by faculty-supervised dental hygiene and dental therapy students from the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry, UCare's MDC partner.

The clinic is a specially designed, wheelchair-accessible, 43-foot dental office on wheels. The MDC has three dental chairs, state-of-the-art instruments, chairside digital radiography and an electronic health record system. This clinic on wheels visits several sites in the metro and greater Minnesota each year.

Any member with a UCare dental benefit may schedule an MDC visit. Members can call to schedule an appointment 8 am – 4:30 pm, Monday – Friday, at 1-866-451-1555 (TTY users call 1-800-627-3529).
