UCare service areas and enrollment updates

Thank you for your continued partnership as we made the difficult decisions to implement enrollment freezes and service area changes. Here is a summary of these changes by product, including changes for 2026:

UCare's Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO) and Minnesota Senior Care Plus (MSC+)

- 2025 and 2026 Service Area: No changes. Service area map
- **2025 and 2026 Enrollment:** No enrollment freeze (still accepting new members)
 - Please note that even if household members are impacted by a change to another plan, those on MSHO and MSC+ will continue with UCare.

UCare Connect (non-integrated SNBC) and UCare Connect + Medicare (integrated SNBC)

- 2025 and 2026 Service Area: Service Area Map
 - **UCare Connect:** No changes.
 - **UCare Connect + Medicare:** 2026 service area reduction to 14 County Metro
 - UCare Connect + Medicare will remain in: Anoka, Benton, Carver, Chisago, Dakota, Hennepin, Isanti, Mille Lacs, Ramsey, Scott, Sherburne, Stearns, Washington and Wright counties.
 - During the Annual Health Plan Selection period, members will be notified of this change and provided with their options for coverage in 2026.

UCare Connect (non-integrated SNBC) and UCare Connect + Medicare (integrated SNBC) continued

2025 and 2026 Enrollment:

- **UCare Connect:** New enrollment frozen in counties where there is at least one other non-integrated SNBC option, which are the following counties: Aitkin, Anoka, Becker, Benton, Carlton, Carver, Chippewa, Chisago, Cook, Cottonwood, Crow Wing, Dakota, Fillmore, Freeborn, Hennepin, Isanti, Jackson, Kanabec, Kandiyohi, Kittson, Koochiching, Lac Qui Parle, Lake, Le Sueur, Lincoln, Lyon, Mahnomen, Mille Lacs, Morrison, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles, Norman, Olmsted, Ramsey, Red Lake, Redwood, Rice, Rock, St. Louis, Scott, Sherburne, Stearns, Swift, Todd, Wadena, Washington, Wilkin, Wright, Yellow Medicine.
- UCare Connect + Medicare: No enrollment freeze (still accepting new members)

Prepaid Medical Assistance Program (PMAP) and MinnesotaCare

• **2025 Service Area:** Reduction to 33 Counties (effective September 1, 2025). <u>Service</u> area map

2025 Enrollment:

- **PMAP:** New enrollment frozen in ALL 33 counties, with the exception of newborns whose mother is on UCare.
- MinnesotaCare: New enrollment frozen in Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Scott and Washington counties, unless a household member is already enrolled with UCare.
- **2026 Service Area and Enrollment:** UCare will confirm the 2026 PMAP and MinnesotaCare service area and enrollment status once contracts are finalized with DHS.

Quarterly statewide check-in meetings

Quit Smoking and Vaping Program for Maternity

UCare offers a special program to help UCare members who are planning a pregnancy, pregnant or postpartum to quit smoking, chewing tobacco and vaping. Members have access to specially trained quit coaches, greater intensity of behavioral support with relapse prevention and more outbound coaching calls (unlimited inbound calls).

Eligible pregnant and postpartum members who call the quit line to complete an initial assessment will receive a \$25 gift card.

- UCare's Health Improvement Specialists to help complete consent forms and assist with community resources (based on availability)

Hosting requirements:

- Adequate space for service delivery (our flu clinics have served various sites such as community events, health fairs and senior sites)
- One on-site contact for support on clinic day
