

Title: Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) for Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Prevention - NCD 210.15

Decision: The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that the evidence is sufficient to cover drugs used for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) for beneficiaries with risk of HIV infection for the treatment of HIV prophylaxis.

What this means: Medicare benefits now include coverage of drugs used for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) services if required components for PrEP are met. Requirements are outlined in the National Coverage Determination (see the link below).
