Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee opportunities

UCare seeks health care providers to serve on the P&T Committee. The committee manages formularies across all lines of business, reviews new-to-market drugs, authorization criteria and ensures a safe and clinically effective pharmacy benefit for members.

Eligibility

Committee member applicants must:

- Be a licensed physician or pharmacist in good standing
- Have clinical experience in primary care, ambulatory pharmacy practice, internal medicine or specialty care
- Be able to attend five P&T virtual meetings per year

Responsibilities

Committee member applicants must:

- Review clinical evidence and recommendations provided by UCare staff
- Provide recommendations on drug therapy coverage and placement on formularies
- Support UCare's compliance with pharmacy regulatory requirements

Participation benefits

- Stay current with new-to-market drugs, clinical guideline changes and clinical best practices
- Collaborate with other health care professionals across disciplines
- Receive a stipend to cover time spent in meetings and reviewing P&T material

Additional UCare committee opportunities

UCare values input from network clinicians. For providers who are interested in getting involved, there are two additional committees whose membership relies heavily on external clinicians: the Credentialing Committee and the Quality Improvement Advisory and Credentialing Committee (QIACC).

Eligibility

Committee member applicants must:

- Be physicians and other clinicians in the UCare network.
- Meet attendance criteria:
 - Credentialing Committee applicants must attend most monthly virtual meetings throughout the year (mornings for approximately one hour on the second Tuesday of the month).
 - QIACC the ability to attend four 90-minute morning virtual meetings per year.
