

Disease Management

Asthma Education Program

UCare's Asthma Education Program is designed to help our members ages 5 – 64, who are living with asthma. The program includes one-on-one phone calls with a UCare Registered Nurse or Respiratory Therapist to help members better understand and manage their symptoms.

The goal of this program is to promote healthy living with asthma. Members can learn how to manage their asthma



triggers, symptoms, and medications. They will gain knowledge in the importance of developing an Asthma Action Plan with their Provider, and the vital role this plan plays in managing their asthma.

A UCare Asthma Education Program materials folder is sent to members enrolled in the program. The contents have valuable tips, tools and resources including an Asthma Trigger Checklist, Asthma Action Plan, Home Environment Checklist and an information book: Living Well with Asthma (adults), or Asthma and Your Child (children).

Health Coaching Programs

Diabetes Health Coaching (All Plans)
Heart Failure Health Coaching (All Plans)

Migraine Management Program (PMAP, MNCare, MSC+, Connect, Connect + Medicare)

The goal of our health coaching programs is to promote healthy living for members living with diabetes, heart failure and migraines. Our health coaches partner with and meet the member where they are at in their health journey. Health coaches help guide members to define their vision for change and set SMART goals. They collaborate with members to explore barriers to making changes and empower them in taking small and manageable steps to improve their self-management. Members are given resources and will work with their coach to create the best path for change.



Medtronic Telemonitoring Program



Heart Failure (All Plans)

Medtronic's heart failure program is a remote monitoring program designed to help manage congestive heart failure. The program includes daily health check monitoring via tablet technology; RN outreach to members to encourage engagement and care plan compliance; alert-based intervention; and outreach

to health plan care team or physicians as necessary to assist members with their chronic condition.

Interactive Voice Recorded Education (Mary Beth)

Diabetes and Asthma Programs

(UCare identified members)

Members are identified to receive automated phone calls, with an option to opt-in to text messages, if they have a diagnosis of either diabetes or asthma. Phone calls occur either weekly or monthly. The outreach is from Mary Beth, who provides education and helpful tips for self-management of diabetes or asthma. Members are asked condition-related questions during each outreach and depending on the members' response may result in an alert to the disease management staff for follow-up. For members needing additional support, they are offered health coaching or asthma education. This program is available in both English and Spanish.

Brook Health Companion App

Diabetes, Hypertension and General Wellness (All plans)

UCare has teamed up with Brook to bring our members their Health Companion program. Brook helps members manage their general wellness, diabetes, hypertension, and other chronic conditions from their smartphone. All members are eligible. The app lets members chat with dieticians and health coaches any day of the year to help members turn goals into sustainable habits. Members can schedule reminders to take medication and to check their blood sugar and blood pressure. Resources and tools within the app can assist members in reaching their health goals. Additional programs to assist in maintaining and improving health include:

- Boost for Better Health: Building healthy habits
- Brook Boost for Better Blood Sugar: Support with type 2 diabetes
- Brook Boost for Better Blood Pressure: Support with hypertension
- Stress Management: Improve stress management skills

Connect Redesign Implementation Monthly Activity Log Reminder:

Per normal process, members that are due for an annual reassessment were returned two months in advance of their due date. For members that were returned in November and December where outreach results in UNABLE TO REACH or REFUSAL, remember to add this data to the January 15th Monthly Activity Log currently posted on the Care Management and Care Coordination home page. This log is able to receive 2022 activity dates.

A new/updated Monthly Activity Log will be communicated via an ALERT mid-January and posted to the home page. The new/updated log will be used beginning February 2023.

Beginning in January 2023, members that are unable to be reached or declining care coordination will no longer be returned to UCare. As care coordinators complete ongoing contact with these members, the intention is to continue to foster relationships, and provide ongoing education to support further engagement with members.

A January update will be sent via email to each County/Delegate's identified Leaders. If you do not receive the update, please inquire with your Leadership and/or check with your Liaisons. We want to be sure everyone gets the information they need. Thanks so much for your continued efforts and support as we embark on the final steps of the Connect Redesign.

Updating a Member's Primary Care Clinic

All Care Coordinators should be confirming member's primary care clinics and completing the Primary Care Clinic Change Request form located on the UCare <u>website</u> in the Care System or County PCC/Care Coordination Change Process drawer. This will ensure members (MSC+/MSHO) are correctly assigned for care coordination while they are in the program and when they age in.
